Happy New Year and welcome back! I hope the winter break brought you some much needed rest and relaxation.

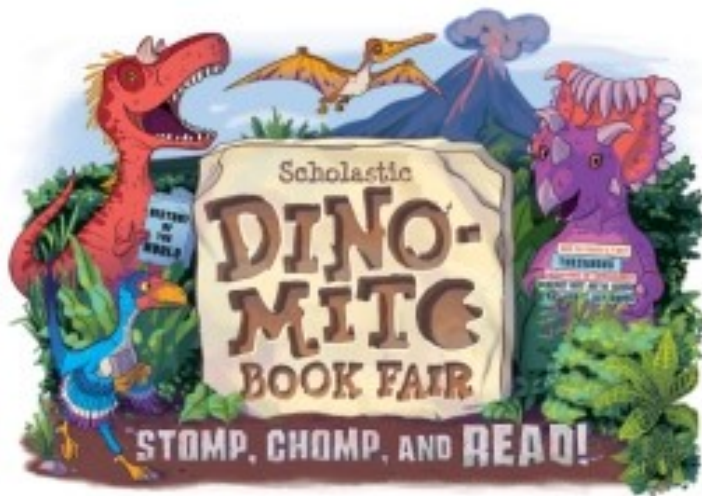
We have so many exciting things planned for the second half of this school year. An updated calendar was sent home in your child's Tuesday folder. Remember to mark your calendars for all these great events.
