Happy January Lead Mine Families!

Our New Year has gotten off to a spectacular start here at Lead Mine and we have been so excited to see and hear everyone starting off this new calendar year with so many smiles and positive outlooks on what is yet to come. The cold weather is back and we are all hopeful that the precipitation stays away while our temperatures remain below freezing for the rest of this winter season.

Please remember to ensure that your child dresses warmly each morning as they are preparing for school. We want everyone to be comfortable throughout the school day. Jackets, Coats, hats, gloves and pants are strongly encouraged for everyone who waits for a bus, walks to school, or goes outside for recess. Please contact your child's teacher if you have any questions, concerns, or need support in providing any of these articles of clothing for your child.

We are starting to see the building improvements that each of our students worked so hard to raise funds for during our Leopard Laps Fun Run this fall.

- -Our playgrounds are being cleaned, repaired, and will be painted when the temperatures are optimal this Spring. New mulch will be going down to provide for better drainage and safety while students are playing off the ground.
- -The reception area will be getting new flooring along with the nurses station. The carpet will be removed and a luxury vinyl tile will be put down for easier cleaning, better sanitation and a longer lasting surface.
- -The Lead Mine Media Center is scheduled to have new carpet put down, will be painted, and the old furniture will be replaced with more comfortable and inviting lounge and work spaces for students to enjoy.
- -The Art Room will soon be sporting new tables, chairs, a large drying rack, brand new kiln, and a new layout to meet the needs of all learners who enter that space.
- -In addition, we have ordered and begun receiving over \$3,000 in new books/titles for our Media Center.

 Altogether we will be seeing more than \$40,000 in building upgrades taking place over the next few months and this is all being done with the funds that you raised during the Fun Run along with funds from the school and the district.

We at Lead Mine are proud of our history of teaching, learning and community. A person who has been a part of our school community for a long while will be retiring in February and we want to be sure to let everyone know how much we have appreciated and will miss Coach C. Ms. Cruickshanks will be retiring as of February 15th and will begin a different pace as she is more able to spend time with her husband, children, mother and mother-in-law. We are excited for Coach C and we wish her all the best as she transitions into a fantastic new stage of life.

A team of teachers was able to interview candidates for the Physical Education position that will be open when Coach C's retirement begins. That team chose a candidate who has been recommended to the Board of Education and will begin February 19th. As soon as this recommendation is made official, we will share more information about our new PE Teacher.

As we are preparing for the 2019 calendar year, we will be adding our NC testing dates/calendar to the master calendar online. Our testing schedule will take place as follows unless any unforeseen circumstances take place.


