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We're excited to announce the launch of a composting program at Lead Mine Elementary! Students will be able to start composting their food scraps and paper products at lunch time, starting April 9th! CompostNow (https://compostnow.org/) will come each week to collect our carts and replace them with clean ones!

What's compostable? A lot! CompostNow can accept any food (including meats, bones, and dairy), coffee grounds / filters, tea bags (just remove the staple!), any soiled paper or cardboard, pizza boxes and much more. (Learn more here; https://compostnow.org/compostables/)

"If it grows, it goes!" "When in doubt, throw it out!"

What happens to the compostables? They are processed at a local commercial composting facility, which turns all that waste into compost! The compost we create will be shared with CompostNow's network of community gardens. (Check them out here: https://compostnow.org/garden-partners/). Our school will also receive compost for our school garden!

Want to compost at home too? CompostNow has a home collection service.
