Welcome Back to Lead Mine for the 2018-2019 School Year!

Dear Lead Mine Elementary School Families,

Welcome to the 2018-2019 school year! The start of a new school year is an exciting time for all of us. To assist you in making the start of the school year a smooth transition, we want to provide a calendar of events. If you have questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

<u>Kindergarten Staggered Entry</u>: Our kindergarten students will participate in "staggered entry" again this year. Students were assigned one day between Monday, August 27th and Thursday, August 30th to attend a full day of school. This special effort allows our young students the opportunity to get to know their new school and allows our kindergarten team the chance to learn more about the students.

<u>Kindergarten Meet the Teacher</u>: This special event is held after the staggered entry process has been completed, Friday, August 31st 12:30 PM – 2:00 PM. All kindergarten students and parents are invited to campus to meet their teachers. This is a regular school day for 1st – 5th grades. Kindergarten parents are encouraged to drop by during this 90-minute event to meet their teacher and visit their classroom.

Open House: This annual event is slated for Monday, September 17th. We will hold two classroom information sessions for each teacher. This will allow parents who have more than one child at Lead Mine an opportunity to visit both teachers. You will receive more information about this in the coming weeks. The schedule for the event is:

5:30-6:00 pm Session #1, Parents visit their child's classroom. 5:10-6:40 pm Session #2, Parents visit their child's classroom.

<u>Carpool</u>: Our carpool procedures will remain the same for the new school year. Families may take advantage of carpool during morning drop off and/or afternoon pick up. If you have not yet picked up your carpool number, please come to the front office to do so at your earliest convenience. Families who have had carpool numbers in the past will retain those numbers, but will still need to pick up a new tag. New tags ensure that the right students get in the right cars with the right adults.

<u>Hours</u>: Our school hours are the same: 8:30 AM - 3:00 PM. Students may be dropped off between 8:00 AM - 8:25 AM. Morning carpool ends at 8:25 AM. If you arrive on campus after 8:25 AM for morning carpool, please park and walk your child in to the front office.

We dismiss at 3:00 PM each day. Please be patient and understand that the first week or two run a little slower to ensure the safety of everyone. In order to decrease your wait time plan to arrive on campus at 3:15 PM until the processes and routines are familiar to everyone.

<u>Before and After School Childcare Program</u>: Lead Mine hosts a before-school program (7:00-8:00 am) and an after-school program (3:00-6:00 pm). If you are interested in either, please pick up a registration form from the school office or register at Meet the Teacher. Are They Ready?

Consider your child's age and maturity level before you agree to let them join a social networking website or download apps. Spend time with your child online and talk about the dangers of the internet.

Communicate.

Create a set of rules for internet usage. Talk about the risks. Keep the lines of communication open!

Educate.

Teach your child good standards for internet behavior. Have your child teach you how they use the internet.

Monitori

Review the websites and apps your child uses. Make sure you have a copy of all their passwords. Avoid including your kid's name, photo, or personal details in their username or gamertag.

Be Involved.

Turn on parental controls and privacy features. Stay engaged with your child about their internet usage.
