Register or Re-register to Volunteer. Any adult who volunteers in a Wake County School must be approved as a volunteer. So, if you are planning to help in your child's classroom or attend a field trip this year, you must complete the registration process. Everyone must re-register each school year. The process can be completed from a computer at ANY WAKE COUNTY SCHOOL. If this is your first time registering you will need your Driver's License and Social Security number. If you just need to re-register, you will only need your Social Security number. Stop by the Media Center before or after school, or even during your lunch hour, to complete your registration.


