4th Quarter WALK to School Day


Wednesday May 17th at 7:30am

EOG SCHEDULE AND HELPFUL HINTS

Tuesday, May 30 - Reading EOG, 3rd - 5Th grades Wednesday, May 31 - Math EOG, 3rd - 5Th grades Thursday, June 1 - Make-up EOG Friday, June 2 - 5th Grade Science Monday, June 5 - 3rd Grade Read to Achieve

Please make every effort to have your child at school ON TIME each day of testing. Check family calendars for appointments that may need to be changed. Testing will begin by 8:30 am. If you have a student taking EOG's, there are lots of ways you can help him or her to do her best.

Try the following:

- Be extra POSITIVE and encouraging.
- Talk to your child about any concerns he or she may have.
- Make sure your student has some "downtime" in the evening and gets plenty of rest.
- Ensure a great start to the day by making sure he or she eats a good breakfast.
- Encourage your child to go to bed early.
- Send a sweater or jacket so students can be comfortable while testing.
